Student Driving and Parking

The student use of automobiles on school grounds is a privilege and governed by Board of Education policy and motor vehicle laws.

Vehicles found out-of-compliance with school parking regulations may be towed from the campus at the expense of the vehicle's owner. This privilege may be revoked for improper use of a motor vehicle, disregard for safety, or lack of compliance with other school rules.
